1. Discussion about the dairy breakfast that was on 6/20/09. Lisa and Lil' manned the booth. They reported that there were 41 surveys filled out, that people were responsive to them and the message of BCAAPC.
 2. The next event will be the fair in Webster July 9, 10, 11. BCAAPC will be having a booth and we will need volunteers to man the booths. Please check your schedules and let Lil' know what shift will work for you.
 3. Lil is still checking into other possible events such as the water cross in Grantsburg, music in the park, the Ag. Fair.
 4. Lil will be emailing everyone a copy of the environmental scans, please fill out as many as you can. On the top of the scan just put where you are, such as Wayne's Grocery or Holiday Station in Siren.
 5. We need volunteers to help distribute the community perception surveys. Some ideas were to be in front of the grocery store and give out hotdogs or water if a community member fills out a survey; go to the beach and give out water or sodas, Salvation Army, probation office, Access, Jail, Drug Court participants.
 6. If you come across any articles in the paper regarding alcohol/drugs/prescription drugs that focuses on our target population, please clip them out and give them to Lil.
 7. We need to have 4 focus groups, 2 that are ages 16-20 and 2 that are 21-34, with 6-8 people per focus group. Brittany volunteered to get participants in the 16-20 age groups. We need someone to help recruit people from the 21-34 age group. Please let Lil know if you are willing to help, or know of people who live in diverse areas of our county (ie: not just 6-8 people from Siren only), which may be able to participate. Please remember that a part of our Capacity Building is cultural competency and thus it would be extremely helpful to have that representation in our focus groups.
