1. Introductions.

3. Approval of the corrected minutes.
4. Tomorrow (11/24/09) we are on the agenda for County Highway Safety meeting. Tracy Horel has made maps indicating where the liquor licenses/entities are located as well as OWI's. Discussion if the map could go previous to 2005 to see if we are progressing.
5. Billboard/logo contest - Lil and Jill will meet briefly after today's meeting. Jill to get Lil Frederic's contact information.
6. Implementation plan has been approved.
7. Discussion of have training for youth advocates. Lil to email Jill, Kara, Jessica. "Take It Back" model. Have training before February. Possible weekend retreat. Maybe kids that have been trained in Crawford County come down and help. Have SCT SPF-youth involved also. Possibly partner with Barron County.
8. Discussion of getting youth involved with PSA's, meetings, etc. Giving youth a voice to get our community awareness up.
9. 1st year of grant we need to collect data to see where we are.
10. Law enforcement training – all officers in Burnett County a refresher course for field sobriety testing. Hands on with LE, with saturation patrols, party patrol procedures.
11. Rules of SPF does not allow to fund safe ride. Chuck said the tavern league could help with advertising safe ride and BCAAPC.
12. Prescription Drug Committee meeting on 11/05/09 had a good turnout. Representation from law enforcement, Human Services, clinic staff, Dr. LaRoque and his replacement. Next meeting will be 12/01/2009, please RSVP to Rob, SCT PD will provide the food. This will replace the BCAAPC meeting for December. There were no representatives from the pharmacy. The next meeting will hopefully have more medical providers, reps from pharmacy and more law enforcement.
13. Discussion of collection of prescription medication. Having a medication drop-off-disposal. Possible ideas were sheriff's department, crematorium, and pharmacy drop-off. Bridget to call state crime lab to see if they can destroy.
14. PWHLTM – Lil, Bridget, and Doug went to CESA 11 for a meeting – same as last year-bombard people/community, flyers, and yard signs starting in April. If you want to be a part of this committee email Lil.
15. BCAAPC website is under construction.

16. Parent teacher conferences – Patty and AJ brought the tri-fold to Grantsburg for PT conference. Tessa, Lil, Kendra, and Allison were at the Webster school PT conferences with the tri-fold.
17. Discussion of having flyers for law enforcement to hand out when they bust a party. Handout would have information on the dangers and have statistics. Also have a handout to give to parents when they pick up their child.
18. Discussion of having a presentation on the YBRS results to law enforcement, tavern league, etc. Lil to address this with Karen.
19. Tavern League thinks alcohol compliance checks are just a sting. Lil and Bridget to attend Tavern League meeting on 12/08/09 @ 2pm @ Northwoods. Tavern League meetings are the second Tuesday of the month. BCTL.org is their website.
20. Media committee - Chuck Anderson, Renee' Nañez, and Lil volunteered to be on this committee.
21. Accident rate has sky rocketed. 3 accidents, 2 for sure were alcohol related. There was a fatality this weekend, not sure of alcohol was involved Bridget reported.
22. Paul suggested having a sign at crash sites that read this is a location of an alcohol related fatality. Also having a billboard in the center of the county keeping track of OWI related crashes and OWI's – update monthly. Maybe have three columns for OWI's/Crashes/fatalities.
23. Chuck reported that the tavern league is working on getting the blood draw tested for drugs also. Currently if blood draw tests positive for alcohol no further testing is done to see if drugs were a factor.
