- Update on DFC mentorship grant with ICAA. It was awarded to us and Taylor County. Only ten given out nationally and only us in WI. Our first meeting is Friday 9/30/11 @ 11:30am in the prevention office.
- CIA were handed out and requested to be filled out and handed back to Lil before leaving today. We really need the 12 sector representation.
- A student was wearing an above the influence sweatshirt at a football game in Webster – we are always working on getting youth involvement.

Doug also reported at a Tribal level-SCT and all entities exceptions are gaming stations/smoke shop/gas station are going smoke free starting 10/01/11. Ceremonial tobacco is allowed but commercial tobacco prohibited. Employees will be on 3 strikes you're out policy.
